## Support of a Boycott of Two Seattle Hyatt Hotels

WHEREAS the Hyatt Hotels Corporation in mid-2013 entered into a national 1 2 agreement with UNITE HERE, the international union representing hospitality workers; 3 and 4 5 **WHEREAS** that agreement provides for a Fair Elections Process whereby workers in 6 particular hotels may decide whether or not they want a union; and 7 8 WHEREAS workers in Hyatt hotels in Baltimore, Maryland, and Long Beach and 9 Emeryville, California, have, under that Fair Elections Process, chosen to unionize; and 10 11 WHEREAS Richard Hedreen, owner of two Seattle Hyatt hotels – the Grand Hyatt 12 Seattle and the Hyatt at Olive 8, each of which is presently non-union – has chosen not 13 to allow workers in those hotels to utilize that Fair Elections Process; and 14 15 WHEREAS Seattle-based Local 8 of UNITE HERE has called for a boycott of the Grand 16 Hyatt Seattle and the Hyatt at Olive 8, in order to bring about a vote on unionization; 17 and 18 19 WHEREAS workers at those two properties endure unfair workloads and have no job 20 security; and 21 22 WHEREAS support for organized labor and working families has long been a central 23 tenet of the Democratic Party; 24 25 **THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Washington State Democratic Central 26 Committee endorse the boycott of the Grand Hyatt Seattle and the Hyatt at Olive 8 until 27 such time as their workers are given the opportunity to utilize the agreed-upon Fair 28 Elections Process to decide on unionization, and 29 30 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Washington State Democratic Central 31 Committee will encourage our fellow Democrats and other friends throughout King 32 County and the State of Washington to refrain from patronizing either of those two 33 hotels until their workers receive justice. 34 35 36 Submitted by the Labor Caucus to the Washington State Democratic Central Committee for its 37 consideration at its February 1, 2014 meeting in Vancouver.
