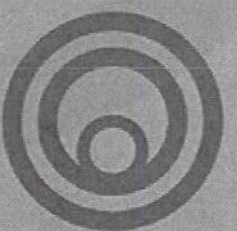

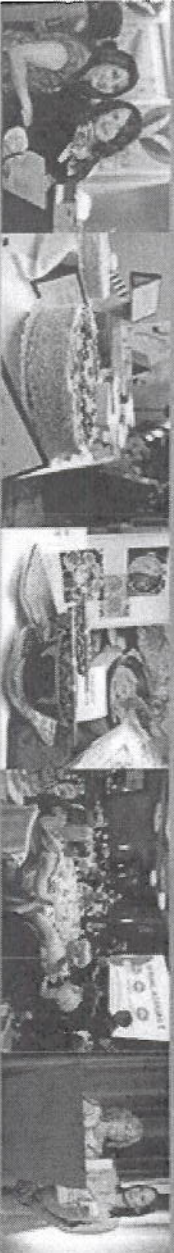

We, like many other Asian, South Asian, and Pacific Islander community leaders and social justice organizations in the Puget Sound, strongly believe that honoring the labor of hotel workers is necessary not only for the welfare of these individuals and their families, but also a cornerstone to strengthening the many communities they belong to. When an employer as large, profitable, and powerful as the Grand Hyatt undervalues the labor of its workers, these workers and others in our diverse communities are left more vulnerable to violence and exploitation.
