I am writing to ask that you allow your workers at the Grand Hyatt and the Hyatt at Olive 8 the right to the fair election process as outlined in the National Agreement between Hyatt Corporation and UNITE HERE. We at the OCA-Greater Seattle chapter have pledged to not patronize or do business with either hotel until workers are able to access that Fair Election Process.

OCA, formerly known as the Organization for Chinese Americans, is a national organization dedicated to advancing the social, political, and economic well-being of Asian Pacific Americans in the United States. We at the local chapter understand the majority of housekeepers at the hotels are Chinese immigrant women working to provide a better future for their families. We stand with our immigrant and American-born brothers and sisters who work in your hotels and are fighting for dignity and respect on the job.

We are one of thirty-one organizations from the Seattle area that have endorsed the Hyatt hotel boycott. Fourteen of these groups are Asian Pacific Islander non-profit organizations and community groups. The list includes the Chinese Information Services Center, the Vietnamese Friendship Association, and the Asian Pacific Islander Coalition.

The OCA-Greater Seattle chapter will continue to honor the boycott and encourage our partners not to patronize either Hyatt until workers receive justice. We urge you to do the right thing and sign on to the Fair Election Process outlined by Hyatt Corporation and UNITE HERE.
